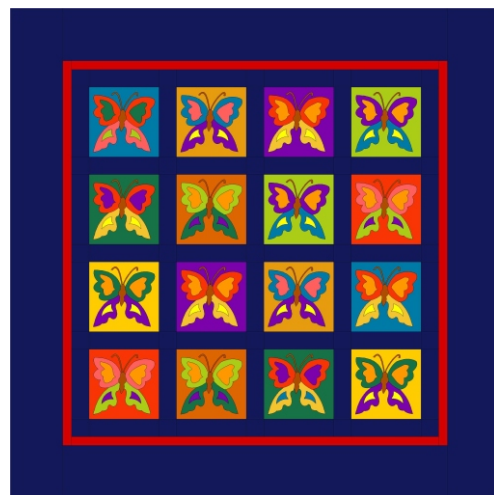

Requirements

- 1 AMAFU colour family roll
- 1.75 m AMAFU marbeleised fabric 150 cm wide
- .25cm AMAFU marbeleised fabric 150cm wide
- 10" X 15 " dark fabric for butterfly bodies.
- 16 X A4 size sheets applique paper
- Variegated polyester embroidery thread for machine
- blanket stitch
- Bobbin fill for embroidery
- Neutral piecing thread for piecing (I use Superior Masterpiece)



Cutting Instructions

1. Cut 16 X 8 1/2" X 8 1/2 " squares from the AMAFU Colour family. Leave the rest for the butterflies.
2. Cut 12 strips 2 1/2 " WOF for sashing. Set aside. Cut 8 1/2 X 2 1/2 " strips from those strips for vertical sashing and set aside.
3. Cut 4 strips 1 1/2 " wide X WOF set aside.
4. Cut 4 strips from left over background fabric : 6 1/2 " X WOF for final border.



Assembly:

1. Trace out or print out the butterfly templates onto the applique paper. Cut out two sets of butterflies at a time and apply to the fabric from the Colour Family roll. Iron to the required two squares and set aside until all sixteen squares have been completed. Embroider the feelers using a narrow satin stitch.

2. Sew around each motif using your favourite machine stitch for applique. 

3. Arrange the completed squares on a design board and assemble as in diagram, using the strips cut for Sashing. See diagram one.

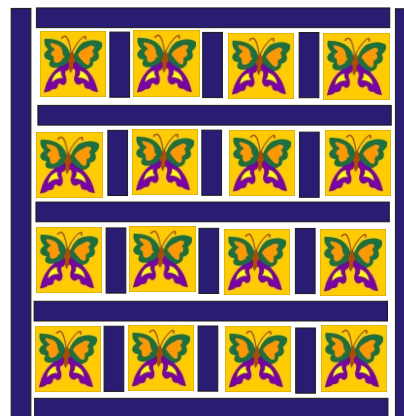

4. Apply 1st Border (1 1/2 " strip), measuring each side as you go. See diagram two.

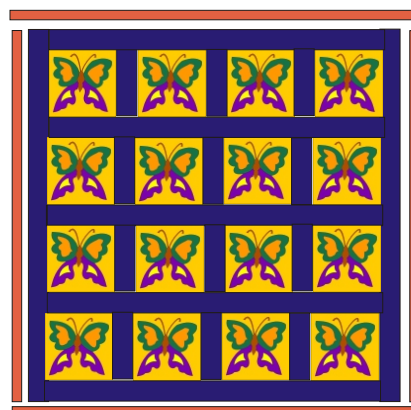

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5. Apply 2nd border (6 1/2 " strip) measuring as you go.

See diagram three.



6. Bat, back and quilt as desired.

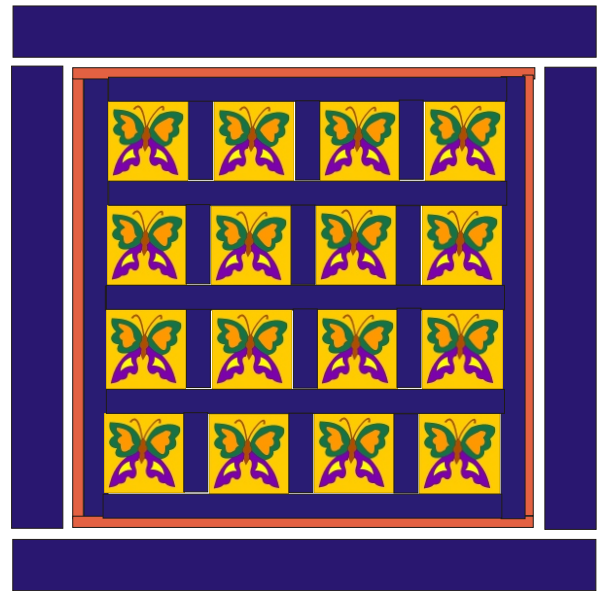
