


Lasange Quilt

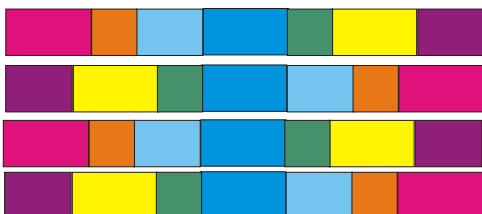
approx 66" X 53"



REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 AMAFU Colour Family Rolls
- 30 cm x 150 contrasting fabric for narrow border
- 1 large ziplock plastic bag

- Stack your fabric pieces in 2 piles of 4 pieces each.
- Cut into 7 strips of 2.5 inches wide.
- You should have 14 sets of 4 strips each.
- Cut each batch of strips into the following rectangles:

- Put all of these rectangles into a plastic bag and give it a good shakeup to redistribute the colours.
- There are two rules:
 - Do not put two rectangles of the same colour together
 - Try not to put two same sized pieces together. .
- Sew all the pieces together, piecing on the short sides so you end up with a long snake. DON'T FORGET TO PRESS THE SEAMS!
- Cut 28 x 44 " pieces off the "snake". Put aside what is left.
- Lay out the strips and when you are happy with what you have, join two pieces at a time, pressing each seam as you go along.



- Trim the edges if necessary and measure for the 1 inch border. Cut a 1 1/2 " strip of a contrasting colour and cut to size for the long borders. Sew on the long borders and repeat the instruction for the short borders (top and bottom)
- Measure each of the long borders again and cut 4 strips the length of the borders off what remains of the "snake".
- Repeat for the short borders and you are done!
